The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Armidale Station

This project is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, a Transport for NSW initiative which aims to provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Key features of the proposed concept design include:

- · upgrading the ramp at the station entrance
- upgrading the existing accessible car spaces
- new ambulant toilets and a family accessible toilet
- a formal bus stop by the station entrance
 - improvements to CCTV, lighting and wayfinding.
