What we're doing

To improve service reliability, Sydney Trains will complete maintenance works around Toongabbie from Friday 17 May to Monday 20 May.

Work activities include deliveries, movement and removal of earthworks stockpiles and materials.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise over the weekend.
- **Work will take place from 6am Friday 17 May to 6pm Monday 20 May.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains may have their engines running on site for an extended period.
Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and parking

- Heavy vehicles will use local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites on Portico Parade.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.


