Killara Station Upgrade

Update on construction work - December 2022/January 2023

Transport for NSW is upgrading Killara Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Further to the December/January community notification sent out last week, please note the following updates to the scope of work included in that notification.

Culworth Avenue work

On Monday 5 December between 8am and 6pm, work will commence on the installation of a temporary pedestrian crossing on Culworth Avenue to provide pedestrians safe access to the train station. Signage will be in place to provide directions for pedestrians and traffic control will be in place at all times.

Weekend work

From 8pm Friday 13 January to 2am Monday 16 January, work is planned at Killara Station during a scheduled shutdown, when trains aren't running and the station is closed. During this time, Culworth Avenue will be closed between Marian Street and Lorne Avenue and detours will be in place.

During the weekend work, the bus stop on Culworth Avenue will be relocated to Lorne Avenue, approximately 120 metres from the existing bus stop.

For the work to be completed safely the footbridge at the station will be closed. Alternate pedestrian routes to the bus stop on Lorne Avenue and Culworth Avenue can be found at Stanhope and Powell streets. Signage will be in place to assist pedestrians. Thank you for your understanding.

Work on Werona Avenue

From Monday 16 January until March 2023 the bus stop on Werona Avenue will be relocated to Locksley Street so work to remove the existing footpath and construct the new footpath is undertaken.

Equipment used for this work includes excavators, concrete and delivery trucks and powered hand tools.

Any impacted residents will also be contacting individually. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this work and thank you for your patience as we carry out this important work.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturdays.

Completion of this work is dependent on several factors including weather and site conditions and is subject to change. We will advise you if dates are changed.
