

Killara Station Upgrade

Construction Update | March 2023

Transport for NSW is upgrading Killara Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Work is progressing well at the station. In February, we continued internal upgrades to the platform building and installed the structural steel lift shafts and screens on the new bridge deck (pictured). We also carried out work to install new disability compliant footpaths on Culworth Avenue, including new kerbs, gutters, and concrete pavement.

Upcoming work in March

Construction work will continue throughout March and includes:

- ongoing work on the station building and toilets
- installation of the bus shelter on Culworth Avenue
- footpath upgrades on Werona Avenue
- installation of screens, awnings and finishing work for the new bridge
- electrical work.
- fit out of the new lifts.

Equipment used for this work includes excavators, cranes, tower lights, concrete delivery trucks and powered hand tools.

Night work – 20 March to 23 March

From **Monday 20 March to Thursday 23 March**, night work is planned at Killara Station between **11pm to 4am** each night, when the station is closed, and trains will not be running.

Work will include the installation of the canopies for the new station footbridge and will require the use of a crane and lighting towers. Work will be carried out at night to minimise the impacts on vehicle and pedestrian movements and ensure the safety of our workers and the public. Directly impacted residents will be individually contacted in advance of the work.

During this time, **Culworth Avenue will be closed** to allow for the set-up of the crane. Traffic and pedestrian detours will be in place. Please follow the directions of traffic controllers. Thank you for your patience we complete this important work.

Station footbridge temporarily closed

To ensure the safety of our workers and customers, the footbridge at the station will be closed during the above night work, from **Monday 20 March to Thursday 23 March** between **11pm to 4am** each night. Alternate pedestrian routes to the bus stop on Lorne Avenue and Culworth Avenue are via Stanhope and Powell streets.

Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians while the work is completed. Please follow the directions on these signs and the instructions of traffic controllers.

Northcote Avenue access point

The Sydney Trains access point at Northcote Avenue is used by our construction crews to carry out planned activities for this upgrade. The site is used by our workers to access the railway tracks to carry out work.

During standard construction hours, the access site is also used as a temporary storage area for materials and supplies required by our planned work. It is also used during weekends when trains are not operating, and it is safe to access the rail corridor to conduct construction work. From time to time, the site is also used by maintenance and other rail workers.

We appreciate that sometimes work in the rail corridor may be disruptive. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this work and thank you for your understanding.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturdays**.

Completion of all work is dependent on several factors including weather and site conditions and is subject to change. We will advise you if dates are changed.
